Course description Learn to create a sense of energy in your watercolours using bold colour and expressive brush strokes. Demonstrations and guidance will encourage you to improve your skills.

Materials to bring All your watercolour equipment, plenty of good quality paper, paints, palette, brushes and board to rest on. Paper should be stretched if possible, otherwise taped to a board.

Refreshments: Tea, coffee and biscuits are provided. There are small cups in the venue, do bring your own mug if you wish.

Parking: There is no parking available at the venue (with the exception of the Tutor). Please respect this and other users of the Hall. Public Car Parks, long & short stay, are available nearby in the town.
