## Intro to Interior Design with Dena Corry

**Dena Corry** qualified in Interior Design at Chelsea School of Art following which she worked with several London design companies delivering high end interiors for private clients both in this country and overseas. Dena moved to part-time design work and developed her teaching practice in the life-long learning sector, initially in London and then Wiltshire, following a move to the country. For the past 12 years Dena has continued delivering interiors through her freelance design business alongside teaching certificated Interior Design courses at colleges in Wiltshire. Dena has a wealth of knowledge and is keen to support you to develop your own design style, plan beautiful spaces and share your vision with others.



### Course description

This is a beginners course and is designed for anyone who has an interest in Interior design or decoration and would like to learn the basic skills necessary for presenting ideas or simply how to effectively plan a space. It is for both people who wish to pursue a career as a designer, or simply get ideas for their own home.

Students will work from a given brief and will produce working drawings, floor plans, elevations and then a mood board that will illustrate all the fabrics, finishes and images showing the overall 'look' of the scheme.

There will also be colour mixing where students will create specific colour schemes using gouache paint, which will imbed a greater understanding of the make up of paint colours. This will also help when trying to decide on a colour scheme for a room.

Students will learn how to 'render' a drawing by choosing some fabrics and finishes

and using coloured pencils, colour a room outline to reflect the chosen samples. In all, an enjoyable and interesting way to share ideas, meet like-minded people, be guided by an expert whilst learning design skills.

Weeks 1-3 Learning about scale, producing working drawings and elevations.

Weeks 4-5 Colour mixing and painting out specific colour schemes.

Week 6 Learn how to render a drawing using coloured pencils.

Weeks 7-8 Producing finished and scaled floor plans and elevations. Producing a Mood Board.

### **What to bring:**

For week one you will need:

- A4 Lever Arch folder, punched pockets and a pen (handouts will be provided).

Dena will provide details of the other equipment needed to complete the course during this first session which include:

- Gouache paints- Primary blue, red and yellow. Black and white
- A scale ruler showing scale 1:50
- Tee square
- Set square
- Drawing pencils and pens
- A4 tracing paper
- A piece of poly/foam board
- Double sided tape, masking tape, glue stick
- A folder or portfolio for transporting drawings

**Refreshments:** Tea and coffee are provided. Please feel free to bring your own refreshments if you have a particular requirement. Small cups are provided by the venue, if you prefer to drink from a mug you are welcome to bring your own.

**Parking:** The Digby Hall has a public car park. Discounted tickets are available from the machine in the Digby Hall foyer.
