Stained Glass with Kate Doig

Kate Doig was trained at Bristol School of Art in Architectural stained glass and is a qualified and experienced tutor. As well as teaching the art of stained glass, she creates traditional leaded stained glass panels at her studio, 'Firewolf Glass' as well as taking on restoration projects and commissions. She uses paints, stains and enamels to bring her creations to life. Kate is also one of 100 glass artists worldwide featured in the book 'Creative Glass' (Schiffer)

Course description (Suitable for beginners and intermediates)

This course introduces students to one method of stained glass, that of copper foiling. Students will learn how to follow a design, cut glass accurately and safely, apply copper foil and solder their creation to produce a beautiful piece they can hang.

Those with experience can design their own creation or create something 3D if they wish. (Please note that lampshades are not an option)

Wk 1 Introduction, safety, tools, background to copper foiling technique, producing a design

Wk 2 Choosing or making your design. Choosing colours of glass.

Wk 3 Cutting glass, grinding, applying copper foil.

Wk 4 Cutting glass, grinding, applying copper foil.

Wk 5 Soldering and finishing



What to bring

- Paper, pencil, eraser
- Clothes which can get dirty/stained, apron, closed in shoes (for safety)

Additionally, you may also bring;

- All the materials and equipment needed for your first piece will be provided. If time allows you will be able to buy the glass and materials needed for another personal creation from Kate - approximate cost £15—£20.
- Alternatively you can bring your own materials to use on your own

project. If you have your own glass tools please feel free to bring them with you.

- Bring a camera if you wish to chart your progress.

Refreshments: Tea and coffee are provided. Please feel free to bring your own refreshments if you have a particular requirement. Small cups are provided by the venue, if you prefer to drink from a mug you are welcome to bring your own.

Parking: The Digby Hall has a public car park. Discounted tickets are available from the machine in the Digby Hall foyer.
