Alex Cree studied painting in Canterbury and specialised in Drawing Studies at the Royal Drawing School in London. He specialises in painting and drawing directly from observation. He has exhibited extensively in London and throughout the UK.

Course description

This course is suitable for all abilities.

Beginners will be introduced to the 3 media, and students with more experience will benefit from the advice of a master draughtsman. Pencil is precise, charcoal is bold, ink is liquid, but they can all be used to make monochrome drawing. In this course, students will spend 3 weeks on each medium and 1 week mixing the media.

Weeks 1-3: Pencil

Weeks 4-6: Charcoal

Weeks 7-9: Ink

Week 10: Mixed Media.

Each section will comprise a mixture of subject matter such as still life, portraiture, landscape, copying reproductions and drawing from imagination.



What to bring

Students will need to bring a few pencils of differing hardness (e.g. H, 2B, 6B), a rubber, ruler, sharpener, A4 or A3 sketchpad, 8 sheets of A2 cartridge (or 4 sheets of A1), a few sticks of charcoal both thin and thick, 1 thin brush. Ink and larger brushes are provided.

Refreshments: Tea and coffee are provided. Please feel free to bring your own refreshments if you have a particular requirement. Small cups are provided by the venue, if you prefer to drink from a mug please bring your own.

Parking: The Digby Hall has a public car park. Discounted tickets are available from the machine in the Digby Hall foyer.
