Charlie Baird is a painter in mixed media who has exhibited regularly in galleries the UK, Europe and the USA. Primarily interested in Landscape he is concerned with capturing the mood and essence of a place and time through colour and composition. He has taught numerous painting courses for adults of all ages and ability, as well as being a visiting Artist at schools.



Course Description

The course is open to all-comers, from beginners to more advanced students with painting undertaken in Acrylics. It will involve trying various techniques and colour combinations to assist opening the imagination to landscape painting. Reproductions of contemporary and historical art will be shown during the course with a view to help expand student horizons, inspire and influence and explore possibilities from the traditional to more abstract approaches.

Participants are asked to bring photos to work from as a starting point and the tuition will take you through mark making, colour value, temperature and hue, various combinations of complimentary and non-complimentary colours and composition. All work will be on paper or canvas. Techniques such as palette knife and glazing will be explored.

Materials

Charlie recommends you bring:

- pencils, charcoal, eraser,
- a small selection of artist brushes ,
- selection of acrylic paints which should preferably include: titanium white, ivory black, cadmium red, alizarin crimson, cadmium yellow medium, cadmium yellow light pthalo blue, ultramarine burnt umber, burnt sienna. (Charlie will also bring samples of these and a range of other colours for students to try if needed.)
- either canvas or heavy paper or card to work on

Refreshments: Tea and coffee are provided. Please feel free to bring your own refreshments if you have a particular requirement.

Parking: The Digby Hall has a public pay and display car park.
