Stained Glass - Hanging Decorations with Kate Doig

Kate Doig was trained at Bristol School of Art in Architectural stained glass and is a qualified and experienced tutor. As well as teaching the art of stained glass, she creates traditional leaded stained glass panels at her studio, 'Firewolf Glass' as well as taking on restoration projects and commissions. She uses paints, stains and enamels to bring her creations to life. Kate is also one of 100 glass artists worldwide featured in the book 'Creative Glass' (Schiffer)

Course description This course is suitable for anyone with an interest in making stained glass, from beginners to intermediate practitioners. Using the copper foil technique students will make a decorative piece of stained glass to hang up and display.



Students will learn how to follow a design, cut glass, apply copper foil and solder to produce a beautiful piece they can hang in a window or on a Christmas tree. There may be an opportunity to make more than one piece dependent on size and speed of working.

What to bring

All the basic materials and equipment needed are provided as part of the course fee. Please bring with you:

- Paper, pencil, eraser
- Clothes which can get dirty/stained, apron, closed in shoes (for safety)

Refreshments: Tea and coffee are provided. Please feel free to bring your own refreshments if you have a particular requirement.

Parking: The Digby Hall has a public pay and display car park.
