Leaded Stained Glass with Kate Doig

Kate Doig was trained at Bristol School of Art in Architectural stained glass and is a qualified and experienced tutor. As well as teaching the art of stained glass, she creates traditional leaded stained glass panels at her studio, 'Firewolf Glass' as well as taking on restoration projects and commissions. She uses paints, stains and enamels to bring her creations to life.



Kate is also one of 100 glass artists worldwide featured in the book 'Creative Glass' (Schiffer)

Course Description (suitable for beginners and intermediates)

This course introduces students to the traditional craft of leaded stained glass. Students will learn the whole process from creating a design, cutting the glass safely and accurately, leading up, soldering, cementing and finally cleaning and polishing their creation.

Students will be able to take their leaded stained glass panel home with them.

Templates will be available for students to follow if they wish.

- Wk 1 Designing the panel and creating the 'cut line'
- Wk 2 Choosing and cutting the glass
- Wk 3 Leading up
- Wk 4 Leading up / soldering
- Wk 5 Cementing and finishing

Note: This course is not suitable for people with hand and wrist problems.



What to bring

Paper/ Pencil / Eraser / Clothes which can get dirty/stained, apron, closed in shoes.

Kate will bring a supply of glass materials and the course fee covers the making of one piece during the course. Further materials may be purchased from Kate if time allows.
